Archivist's Corner



We had a great summer in the archives while the museum was closed! The archives volunteers worked on a number of projects:

- We held multiple Collection Cull Sessions and officially discarded (deaccessioned) 350+ items that were non-Coachella Valley and non-Palm Desert materials.
- We made great inroads on our digital file organization by renaming all files with a standardized naming that matches how we organize physical materials. We also managed to delete 300,000+ duplicate digital files that we found while organizing them.
- We've almost completed organizing our Research Files, the last task being to attach proper, typed labels on all the file folders.

We're still working on:

- New Donation Organization we've had some donations recently, so we need to get those materials indexed and organized.
- Photo Scanning We have vintage photos in our collection that need to be scanned and described.


